**10 WAYS TO TREAD LIGHTLY!**

1. Stay only on roads, trails or other areas designated for off-highway vehicle use.
2. Cross streams only where the trail crosses the stream, or at designated fording points. Approach the stream slowly, crossing at a 90-degree angle.
3. You may come upon obstacles on a trail, such as fallen trees. Driving around them can destroy vegetation and widen the trail, so sometimes it's best to move the object or drive over it. Cross obstacles at an angle, one wheel at a time.
4. Try to avoid muddy trails, save them for future trips when they are dry.
5. If driving an OHV on switchbacks, avoid roosting around the apex of the turn when climbing or brake-sliding during descent, both of which gouge the trail.
6. Pack out what you pack in. Carry a trash bag in your vehicle and pick up litter left by others.
7. Following a ride, wash your vehicle and all your equipment to avoid spreading noxious weeds the next time you ride.
8. Observe proper human waste disposal. Bury your human waste at least six inches deep and camouflage the hole or pack out your waste.
9. Always contact the landowner for written permission before crossing private land.
10. Before you leave, obtain a map and contact your local land management agency to develop a route that is safe, legal and within the limitations of your vehicle.

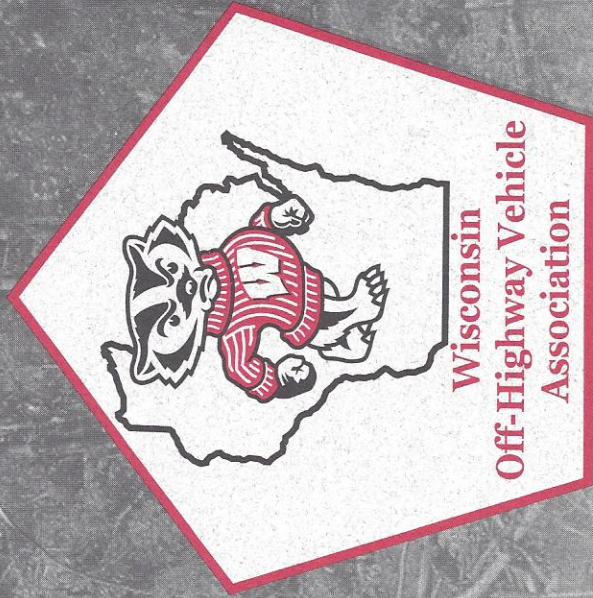
